The James A. F. Stoner Sustainability Centre serves as the focal point of this wing. Within this centre, we house the ERS committee and the Sustainability Club.

The ERS committee comprises one member from each of the seven schools, totalling seven members in total. All of them collaborate closely with the ERS Project Officer.

The Sustainability Club is a student-led initiative with Pavana as the faculty mentor. This club will also establish a partnership with the Teach for India Organization, appointing students as ambassadors. Additionally, in their final years, some students will become Social Fellows.

Within the Sustainability Club, a Net Impact Chapter will be initiated, consisting of four students and an advisor (Pavana).




