

ADMISSIONS AT WOXSEN SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

We look for the “right” candidates who have an appetite to learn and a desire to be a future leader. We, therefore, look for all-round individuals who have the ability to learn in a highly dynamic and competitive hands-on learning ambience. We look for candidates who illustrate leadership qualities through their past experiences, their academic learning, their degree of maturity and intellect and their communication skills and team skills.

The admission decision is arrived at by considering the following factors. No single factor among them is more significantly important than the others. For example a high score in the Woxsen Aptitude Test or any other qualifying test does not necessarily guarantee admission into the PGDM/PGXP program nor a low score, by itself, disqualifies any candidate. Admission decisions are arrived at on the compound score which is computed based on the following factors.

1)ADMISSION TEST: We conduct Woxsen Admissions Test (An on-line/paper exam that shall be offered from September 1st of every year till 31st of May of the subsequent year. However, if the seats for any given year are filled, the test score shall be considered for admission into the next year’s program. The scores are valid for two years. We accept scores from CAT/XAT/NMAT/MAT AND GMAT/GRE/CMAT.

The scores shall be seen along with other factors as mentioned above and a low score does not automatically disqualify any candidate. However, a high score in any of the above-mentioned tests will make one eligible for a scholarship up to 100% tuition fees waiver, provided one submits an application with evidence of strong all-round skills and abilities.

2) ACADEMIC RECORD: We accept students from all backgrounds as long as they have an undergraduate degree with a minimum of 60% marks in the 10th standard, 12th standard and in the undergraduate degree. However, we recognize the fact that it is highly difficult to get high scores in certain streams and in certain universities. We, therefore, arrive at an equivalent score after normalizing the scores based on the highest and lowest marks issued by that particular board/university. We encourage students from non-engineering and non-business backgrounds to apply and offer a 5% scholarship to them, and to all girl students in addition to any other scholarship they obtain because of their merit, to enhance the diversity of the class.

3) ADMISSION ESSAY: It is very important for students to take the opportunity to submit a “Statement of Purpose” to be considered for the Woxsen Merit Scholarships. The students are advised to talk through the essay and explicitly state what compels them to do a Post Graduate Program in business Management at this stage of their life, their short term and long-term goals and their accomplishments till date including those at work place if they have any professional experience. (Part time work shall not be considered.)

4) PERSONAL INTERVIEW: Short listed candidates shall be called for an interview which can be conducted in the campus/our Corporate Office or even in any other city from which we receive significant number of applications. Normally we receive several applications from Metros and big cities such as but not limited to:

Bombay/Pune/Bangalore/Delhi/Hyderabad/Chennai/Kolkata/Ahmedabad/Jaipur(Rajasthan)
Chandigarh etc.,

In addition to the above factors, we take life skills and achievements into consideration for arriving at admissions decisions and for awarding scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Woxsen encourages meritorious students and awards various scholarships ranging from Rs. 1,80,000/-* to 100% tuition waiver. The total worth of Scholarships is in excess of 200 lakhs of Rupees. These scholarships are based purely on Merit. The student must submit the Statement of Purpose to be considered for the Scholarship. There is no separate application for Scholarships. All the students are automatically considered for the scholarship and the decision shall be intimated to the student along with the final admissions decision. The student will be given a week's time to accept admission and pay the commitment fees.

Note: We will revise the amount of scholarship upward, should you submit a test score of 80% and above in any of the admission tests mentioned here under.

CAT, XAT, NMAT, SNAP, GMAT, GRE AND WOXSEN Admission Test.
Or a score of 90 percentile or above in MAT, CMAT and other tests.

THOUGH WE ACCEPT STUDENTS THROUGH THE ADMISSIONS CYCLE, IT MAY PLEASE BE NOTED THAT MOST OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS SHALL BE AWARDED IN THE INITIAL PERIOD AND HENCE THOSE WISH TO AVAIL OF SCHOLARSHIPS ARE ADVISED TO APPLY AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE, AS THE NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS ARE LIMITED AND ARE ON THE FIRST CUM FIRST BASIS.

The application window is open from 1st August 2018 and we accept applications on a rolling basis.
