Dr. P. Swami Sairam, presented the existing PhD program policy and operating guidelines being followed at the university to the committee.

Following addition were suggested to be incorporated into the policy

Coursework:

Coursework of PhD scholars to have 4 credit courses consisting of

- o Research Methodology (Mandatory) 4 credits
- School Specific Course
 4 Credits
- o Research topic/area specific course 4 credits
- o Ethics and Plagiarism
- 0 Credits
- MOOCs courses (if opted) shall be minimum of 56 hours of duration to be accounted as 4 credit course
- A full time scholar will be given 1 year of time to clear their course work, post which they will have to place an appeal for an extension of 6 months to the URC.
- A part time scholar will be given 1.5 year of time to clear their course work, post which they will have to place an appeal for an extension of 6 months to the URC.
- The composition of Doctoral Research Committee (DRC) for scholar should contain maximum of 3 members comprising of 2 subject matter experts from the school and 1 subject matter expert from the other school within the university/outside the university, excluding the supervisor
- Full time Doctoral scholars shall be officially assigned with a maximum of 8 hours/week academic workload, in addition to the administrative workload as deemed fit by the Dean of the School.

Research Proposal:

- URC will define and communicate the dates well in advance for the SRC meeting which shall be conducted twice in a semester
- o A scholar must have achieved minimum of 8 credits in the coursework to be eligible to present his/her research proposal to the SRC committee
