Concept Note:

Pedagogy refers to the study of teaching and learning processes, and it is closely linked to society because education is a fundamental aspect of any society. Education systems are designed to provide people with information and skills, preparing them for participation in society. There are several methods to understand the interdependence of society and pedagogy. First, society impacts the objectives, subject matter, and teaching strategies. For instance, education may emphasise creativity and critical thinking more in societies that respect individualism and innovation. On the other hand, education may emphasise memorising facts and abiding by norms in communities where conformity and obedience are valued. Additionally, pedagogy can influence society by influencing people's views, values, and behaviours. The education system can promote social values such as tolerance, democracy, and equality or reinforce societal inequalities and injustices. This is the relationship between society and pedagogy, but what if both Society and Pedagogy are interpreted differently from the point of view of photography? What can be achieved from this?

Photography is a concrete example of how artistic expression and social forms continually influence and reshape each other. There are many facets in society and many facets of the society; here, the meaning of facets is not in its literal sense but in the form of an adjective which directly means form, feeling, difference, hope-disappointment, expectation, and desire etc. There are many stories in society, some of which are visible and some that require little effort to understand. With the help of natural or artificial light, good lenses and a sensitive eye, photography captures untold and hidden stories realistically, in which there is not even an iota of the lie. How can all these facets be stimulated through photography? This is the subject of a critical discussion. The points on which scholarly dialogue is needed for photography in the social context are as follows:

- 1 Documentary photography and its ability to portray and express the realities of the world.
- 2 Photography as a tool for activism and social change, including historical examples and contemporary movements.
The ethics of photography, including issues of consent, representation, and exploitation
- 3 The role of photography in shaping cultural perceptions and stereotypes
- 4 The impact of new technologies on the production and distribution of photography and its implications for society.





The use of photography for better results of education is a common practice. But still, many dimensions are yet to be explored for better photography education. For example, there should be an intense dialogue on the challenges of photography education. For example, there is a need for more diversity and inclusion in photography education. This includes diversity in terms of race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, and socio-economic status. Educators need to be mindful of these issues and work to create an inclusive and welcoming learning environment for all students. Apart from this, the pedagogy must include adaptability and sustainability in taking pictures and constructing a narrative. Also, Pedagogy should be more inclined towards career readiness. Finally, How real-world experience can be given to the students must be ensured in photography pedagogy. It will provide them with multiple senses of the existing world, whether emotional or practical. The points on which scholarly dialogue is needed for photography in its pedagogical context are as follows:



- 1 Curriculum can be developed more relevant to the social impact and career readiness.
- 2 Teacher training for the latest technology and techniques along with cognitive development, such as critical thinking, visual literacy, social justice, sustainability diversity and inclusion.
- 3 Introducing the flexible rubrics in assessment and evaluation to accurately measure student learning and progress
- 4 Developing a plan for industry relations to create opportunities for internships, mentorship programs, and collaborative projects.
- 5 Appraising the inclusivity and diversity in photography education, including addressing issues such as cultural bias and lack of representation.
- 6 There is a need to encourage innovation and creativity in photography education, including incorporating new technologies and techniques and providing opportunities for students to experiment and explore.

KEYNOTES

Keynote 1 on **Living with Photography** by Dr. Caroline Molloy UCA Farnham (UK)



Dr. Caroline Molloy, Programme Director of Fine Art and Photography, UCA Farnham and Senior Fellow of the Higher Education Academy. Alongside of which she is co-editor of Photomonitor which currently has a residency at UCA. Dr. Molloy shared a wide insights and experiences of her when she took up the photography as her career. According to Dr. Molloy photography is no more a profession but a medium of art which gave insights on the different side of photography. She insisted on developing good technical skills on photography which may lead one to create one's own unique voice and style in photography.

She also added that photography can be used as a way to understand and document different cultures, communities, and representations in photography, such as gender behaviors and background choices. Dr. Molloy shared her work experiences and made statements that photography can be helpful in understanding the physical and cultural context of a space, Examining gestures, costumes, and representations to understand different communities and spaces. She also stated that photography can be a tool to represent the unique perspectives and identities of communities, to address social issues of inequality etc. Dr. Caroline as a photographer uses her art to explore and understand different cultures and communities and worked on various projects that involve interviewing people, researching historical photographs, and examining the politics and social dynamics within different settings, projects related to gender, including representing women in different contexts and exploring issues of gender inequality.

She also shared insights on how photography can be effectively used in portraying and representing diversified peoples, gender and gestures, for social causes and cultural insights. Dr. Malloy concluded by making a note that photography and its versatility can serve as means of artistic expression and exploration.



KEYNOTES

Keynote 2 on
InstaFAKE : Filtered Photography
by Dr. Amit Chawla,
Professor at Amity University, Haryana



Dr. Amit Chawla, professor at Amity University, Haryana gave his perspective on current day photography and filtered photography. Dr. Chawla gave insights on new technology implements and impact of new technologies and Instagram application. He also addressed about facts such as 2.3 billion pictures shot every minute and instagram has about 1.3 billion users where 70% of population on Instagram. Dr. Chawla also added points on the role of Photography in shaping Perceptions and stereotypes. His lines mentioning that the images on Instagram dosent reflect the real life of a person gave a different look about Instagram life.

Dr. Chawla also mentioned the ethics of Photography which included the representation and exploitation in photography, responsibility of photographers to portray truthfully and ethically and importance of consent in photography. He also added comments on rapid evolution of photography and impact of technology on production and distribution. Dr. Chawla gave huge insights on techniques used to create manipulated images, involving in altering reality through filters such as filters to enhance appearance, alter colors, and create unrealistic images, manipulation of body images and beauty standards, staged and fabricated scenes and editing tools which can distort truth and mislead viewers. He also added points on the need for transparency and disclosure in photography, responsibility to accurately represent reality, potential harm of manipulated images, importance of ethical decision-making in photography.

Dr. chawla also mentioned that as a creator and consumers of images, understanding the impact and ethics of photography is important and using photography as a tool for truth and positive change as privacy matters and cultural diversity are often overlooked in social media posts, with little attention given to respecting others privacy and cultural sensitivities. He also stated that Plagiarism and appropriation of others work on social media platforms are unethical, and originality and innovation are valued by employers and clients.



KEYNOTES

Keynote 3 on **Learning and Teaching Photography in India** by Dr. Deepak John Mathew, DoD, IIT Hyderabad

Dr. Deepak John Mathew Former Head, Department of Design and Coordinator DIC, Indian Institute of Technology, Hyderabad spoke about the Technological revolution that happened in photography, from film cameras to digital cameras, and now to smartphones with powerful built-in cameras. Dr. John Mathew stated that photography is no longer just about capturing a moment, but also about creating and editing images and it is important to be mindful of the settings and techniques used in photography to achieve desired results. He also added that as technology continues to advance, and it's essential to stay updated and adapt to new innovations in photography.



Dr. John Mathew also stated that photography is a creative medium, and the use of technology should be balanced with artistic vision and personal skills and should focus on the image rather than solely relying on technology. Dr. John Mathew also shared his experience and thoughts on the use of AI and machine learning in photography has led to advancements such as automated scene recognition, image stabilization, and post-processing techniques and thus photography is now evolved as a multidimensional art form, with 3D imaging, holography, and other cutting-edge technologies pushing the boundaries of traditional 2D photography. He also stated that the democratization of photography through smartphones and social media has led to a proliferation of images, raising questions about authenticity, manipulation, and the role of the photographer as a creator and despite the advancements the artistic vision, composition, and storytelling skills of the photographer remain crucial in creating impactful photographs.

Dr. John Mathew mentioned that as photography is constantly evolving, and photographers need to stay curious, adaptable, and innovative to stay relevant in the rapidly changing landscape of technology and art and should have insights and idea on the ethical implications of using technology in photography, such as image manipulation and privacy concerns. He also stated that the collaboration between photographers and technologists can lead to new and innovative approaches in photography, opening up new possibilities for creative expression when photographers keep learning new technologies, techniques, and trends in photography and can stay competitive in the field and continue to grow as artists.

Keynote 4 on

ART AND REWORK WITH TRIBALS: HOW TRIBAL THINKS?

Mr. Raghu Thomas, HOD and Lecturer, Dept. of Photography, TTWR-FAA, Sircilla, shared his experience and thoughts on current photographs and techniques. Mr. Thomas shared his thoughts that the consumption and understanding of the photography has changed as evolution and changes takes place. He added on that educators need to integrate interdisciplinary approaches into photography education to better contextualize and analyze photographic images in relation to larger social and cultural contexts. He also mentioned that while teaching photography and the changing audience demographics need to be considered when teaching photography aesthetics and added that instagram and other social media platforms have changed the way photography is approached, with a focus on approval and masking.

Mr. Thomas mentioned that photography education should go beyond technical techniques and focus on capturing meaningful images that communicate a message and stated that photography is a medium of communication and not just a means of self-expression. He also shared that as photography has evolved over the years and continues to change in response to societal and technological shifts, the role of photography in society and culture needs to be critically examined and understood by educators and learners. His words which stated that Photography has the potential to create wonders and communicate powerful messages portrayed a different angle on photography.

Mr. Thomas also shared his thoughts on the need to approach photography as an interdisciplinary education considering its role in broader social and cultural contexts and photography as a powerful medium of communication that requires thoughtful consideration of its impact on individuals and society at large. He also gave informations about the Telangana government initiated a program to encourage arts in tribal girls who are underprivileged. The program focuses on teaching photography and fashion designing courses and syllabus is based on JNAFAU. The program aims to empower the girls to pursue careers in creative fields.

It was also said that photography is a creative medium, and the use of technology should be balanced with artistic vision and personal skills.

Insights were given on implementation of AI and technology in photography and how the latest version of mobile have better camera quality and inbuilt filter and edit options. Speakers also mentioned that Collaboration between photographers and technologists can lead to new and innovative approaches in photography, opening up new possibilities for creative expression. 
